Rules of Play & Event Details for 2 Person Scramble

- "Mallard" Green Tees Men under the age of 65
- "Common" Teal Tees Men ages 66-74
- "Pintail" Slate Tees Women of all ages & Men over the age of 75
- <u>Each player must use as least (2) two drives during the round</u> this must be denoted on the scorecard and attested by playing partners. (Playing opponents will be asked to mark and attest your score).
- All putts must be holed out.
- 2 Person with a handicap of 18.0 *or* higher scramble Once a ball is selected for play it must be played from within 1 club length of the original spot. A ball <u>may not</u> be played from an alternate turf condition, i.e. if a ball's original spot was in the rough, the ball must remain in the rough even if the fairway is within the allotted 1 club length and the ball must not be placed closer to the hole.
- Balls being played from within a bunker *or* penalty area (red stakes -or- tall native grass areas) are <u>not granted 1</u> club length.
- By Local Rule: From the tee on Hole #7, the fairway on Hole #5 and the left of that is deemed "Out of Bounds"
- #8 Lower Green is in play



All USGA Rules will govern play with the following highlights:

- The one-ball rule is not in effect.
- Rangefinders and GPS yardage systems will be allowed. Players are allowed to share yardage information.
- The Pace of Play is set at 4 hours 20 minutes...slow play penalties will be assessed as needed by the tournament committee. Caddies and/or fore caddies are allowed.
- Ground under repair is marked with white circles or short white posts. GUR may be determined within your group if there is doubt and a tournament committee member is not available, please play 2 balls and a decision will be made before final scoring is posted.
- Natural Areas are deemed a part of the golf course and should be played as a penalty area and may be identified by red stakes. The boundary of the natural area is defined by the mown edge or cut line.
- The Natural Grassed effigy mounds on Hole #18 are in play relief may be taken at cost of 1 stroke.
- Free relief from the landscaped area left of #8 green. Free drop if ball ends up in this area, no closer to the hole.
- Out of Bounds is identified by white lines or stakes. The O.B. area is defined by the mown edge or cut line. When present, split rail fences that border the golf course are deemed as a boundary fence and are defining O.B. The rock wall located behind #9 green is also a boundary marker and defines O.B. Per rules, any relief taken from physical boundary is done so under "unplayable lie" and is assessed a penalty of 1 stroke.



Scoring, Playoffs & Weather Delays

- Scoring will take place in the Koshkonong Mounds CC Bar Room. Two (2) signatures will be required per card (Player & Attesting Player).
- 1st place ties will be broken via sudden death playoff. Ties for all other places will be broken by means of scorecard playoff going back to the hardest handicap holes (#15, #7, #16, #3, #11, #5, #18.
- No weather delay shall last more than 2 hours.
