GUIDELINES & RESTRICTIONS OF PLAY

Face coverings / Masks:

1. Members & Guests - Face coverings / masks will be required indoors through April 5th per state guidelines. These guidelines may be extended beyond April 5, and we will update as information becomes available. Face coverings / masks will not be required for those actively eating or drinking.
2. Clubhouse staff will be required to wear face coverings / masks as well as clear CDC health protocols prior to beginning their shift.

GOLF & GOLF CARS

1. The golf shop will be open.
 - We will begin taking tee times starting on Thursday, March 25th
 - Tee times may be booked online (www.kmccgolf.com/member-home)
 - Please note your member login information is;
 - Male members: first and last name (all lower case – no spaces)
 - Password: is your member #
 - Tee times may also be booked by calling the golf shop 920-563-2823
 - Tee times will continue to be set at 10-minute increments and limited to four -
or- five players.
 - Guest fees either need to be pre-paid over the phone, or website. Otherwise they will be placed on your account. Current guest fees will be \$20.00 (9) / \$32.00 (18) inclusive of applicable sales tax.
2. Golf cars – (please see appendix 1.1)
3. Push carts – are available but limited in supply. There currently are NO restrictions against them. The club owns 12, and they will be available for members on a first come, first serve basis at no charge. The push carts will be sanitized following each use.
4. Practice areas, including the putting green will be open.
5. Bathrooms – As of now the on-course bathrooms will be open and sanitized daily.
6. Ball washers, Trash bins, Divot sand boxes, spent tee boxes and bunker rakes will be in place.
7. Flags /Pins may remain in the hole *-or-* removed at the choice and discretion of individuals preferences.
8. Social distancing must be always observed. Please take safety measures by utilizing personal protective gear, and sanitation wipes (these will not be provided by the club). DO NOT congregate while on the golf course or in parking lot areas. Please maintain a safe distance of 6' or more from other players or staff members.

APPENDIX 1.1

2021 Cart Policies

We hope that you and your family have been staying healthy and staying safe during this pandemic. Throughout the 2020 season we have allowed single rider carts at no extra charge for our Members and guests upon request.

Although we were able to keep everyone safe, which was our priority, it did come at a cost to the club. Throughout the 2020 season we experienced many negative effects on the golf course and within the cart fleet itself due to the increased usage brought on by single carts usage.

The guidelines in 2021 have been relaxed since the completion of the 2020 season. With drastic reduction in positive cases and increased vaccination numbers we are excited to be returning towards some normality. We will continue to sanitize golf cars after each use and encourage those players riding together not from the same household to wear a face covering. We will continue to offer single rider cart for those in need based on availability. A single rider request will be granted based on availability and will come with an additional charge of \$12.00 for 18 holes / \$8.00 for 9 holes.

The above rates are in addition to posted golf car rental / lease rates. Single rider cars in threesomes will not be charged the additional fee.

FOOD AND BEVERAGE OPERATIONS

1. The bar and restaurant will be open for dine-in, dine-out, or carry-out services.
2. Social distancing must be always observed. Please take safety measures by utilizing personal protective gear, and sanitation wipes (these will not be provided by the club). **DO NOT** congregate while on the golf course or in parking lot areas. Please maintain a safe distance of 6' or more from other players or staff members.
